

Osupplies.com Coupons

If the coupon you are using is specific to a product, you must first add that product to your cart. If it is specific to a certain dollar amount, you just need to reach that amount before you can use the coupon.

Once you go to checkout and your stock check results are displayed, you will select continue checkout. You will now be prompted to add your coupon. You can enter multiple coupons, doing them one at a time.

You will enter the characters before the dash in first box and then remaining characters in second box.
